INTRODUCTION

We are central to a network of value-sharing partnerships with activists, NGOs, CBOs, service providers, Youth Hubs, and Parliamentarians, with whom we make positive change for adolescent health and SRHR.

PURPOSE OF THIS ENGAGEMENT

SAT intends to conduct polls and/or surveys of young people across Southern Africa to better understand attitudes and behaviours concerning health and sexual and reproductive health and rights.

SAT is looking for an agency or consultant with proven track record in youth surveys and/or youth polling and/or market research among youth. The selected agency or consultant will support SAT to design, conduct, analyse, and write up the data collected. The consultancy will be for one year but may be renewable up to end of 2026.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Support SAT to conceptualise and budget for a 27-month plan of youth surveys/market research in the SADC region.
- Design, in consultation with SAT, individual survey instruments for each survey in the plan.
- Conduct, quality manage, analyse and write up each survey.
- Discuss each survey result with SAT staff.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Proven experience in full conducting of all phases of surveys and/or polls and/or market research with young people.
- Strong understanding of adolescents, young people and youth.
- Proficiency in statistical software and data visualization tools.
- Strong communication and interpersonal skills.
- Ability to work independently and meet deadlines.
