## **CALL FOR A BOARD MEMBER (UNDER 25-YEAR-OLD) FOR SRHR AFRICA TRUST (SAT) IN MALAWI**

SRHR Africa Trust (SAT) is a 33-year-old Southern African NGO that seek 'Community' driven and responsive Health system deliver improved outcomes for HIV and SRHR for young people (10-24 years of age). SAT works for universal adolescent access to gender-transformative SRHR in Malawi, and we are an integral part of a network of partnerships with NGOs, CBOs, service providers, Youth Hubs, and activists with whom we have shared values, principles and practices. We envision resilient communities across Malawi that enjoy good health and well-being free from stigma and discrimination.

In accordance with SAT Board Charter 2024, and its seating on 15 August 2024, the board recommended to recruit a young person on its board to represent the aspirations of adolescents and young adults. We are therefore calling for applicants with the following attributes to fill up this position:

The person should be young, below the age of 25 years, who is articulate, knowledgeable and committed to the work of SAT and the plight of adolescents and young adults. S/he should be knowledgeable on SRHR issues, have a good community standing and reputation, and should have good aptitude. Specifically, the person is expected to have:

- a) A sound analysis of the HIV, sexual and reproductive health and rights or community development in the country;
- b) Capacity to understand the process of building community competence;
- c) Ability to work within a multicultural environment and cross-cultural communication skills;
- d) Committed time to operate as a Member of a SAT Malawi Board, at least for two meetings annually;
- e) Commitment to community-based responses to HIV, sexual and reproductive health and rights, social justice and community development;
- f) Commitment to the growth and sustainability of SAT Malawi;
- g) Commitment to observing confidentiality among the Board policies and procedures and
- h) Ability to offer services to SAT Malawi as may be delegated by the Board Chairperson.
- i) Be available for ad hoc consultations with SAT Malawi Management and help to respond to other requests as may be needed.
